Abstract	<p>The collection consists of 14 German posters, 1 diary transcript and 3 playbills from Heidelberg, Germany. All of these items were collected by Dr. Henry King Stanford during his studies at the University of Heidelberg between September 1936 and July 1937.</p>

Biographical/Historical	<p>Dr. Henry King Stanford (April 22, 1916-January 1, 2009) was a lifelong educator and served in the upper administration of several American universities and colleges.</p> <p>Dr. Stanford earned four degrees and 13 honorary doctorates. During his professional life, Dr. Stanford served as president of five different universities. After his retirement in 1981, Dr. Stanford remained active in educational policy and research.</p> <p>This collection resulted from materials gathered during the 1936-1937 academic year when Dr. Stanford completed post-graduate work at the University of Heidelberg. He went to Germany to improve his German language skills and observe German culture. He kept a diary, and he collected posters of the political messages of the day.</p>
